

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids addressed to City of Conway will be received at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, Conway, Arkansas (1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas 72032), until 10:00 am, Tuesday, November 24, 2009, then opened and publicly read aloud, for furnishing all labor, material, and equipment, and performing all work required for SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS – COUNTRY CLUB ROAD AT JULIA LEA MOORE SCHOOL AND FREYALDENHOVEN LANE AT THEODORE JONES SCHOOL. The work includes the construction of approximately 2,280 feet of 5 foot wide concrete sidewalk along with the installation of wheel chair ramps, and related work.

Proposals shall be accompanied by surety in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to City of Conway, Arkansas as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. The notice of award of Contract shall be given by the Owner within sixty (60) days following the opening of bids.

The successful Bidder must furnish a performance bond and a separate payment bond upon the forms provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

A Contractor may submit a bid without having a State of Arkansas Contractor's License. However, prior to executing a contract for this work a Contractor must be licensed by the Arkansas State Licensing Board for Contractors when the cost thereof is Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) or more (reference Act 150 of 1965 (as amended), Arkansas Statutes).

Plans, specifications, proposal forms and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, 1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas and purchased for \$35.00 per set.

The City of Conway hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Acts of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

Federal funds are utilized in this project. The contractor is required to comply with the Federal-Aid Construction Contract provisions contained in the contract documents including Nondiscrimination requirements, Equal Employment Opportunity requirements, Nonsegregated Facilities requirements and Minimum Wage requirements as contained in FHWA 1273 – "Required Contract Provisions Federal Aid Construction Contracts" and supplements thereto.

Proposals will be considered on the basis of cost, the bidder's financial responsibility, his equipment, and his past performance in completing similar work. The City of Conway reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, and to accept the proposal deemed to be for their best interest.
