

## City of Conway Community Development Block Grant Program Announces the 2012 Funding Cycle Training Meeting Dates

Applications regarding the City of Conway's Community Development Block Grant funding cycle for 2012 are available to the public at City Hall (1201 Oak Street) and at [www.cityofconway.org/departments/cdbg/cdbg.html](http://www.cityofconway.org/departments/cdbg/cdbg.html).

The goals of the Community Development Department are to provide a suitable living environment, expanded economic opportunities and decent housing for the city's low- and moderate-income residents.

The 2011-2015 Consolidated Plan for the city identified five investment strategies for CDBG funding:

- Repair and Maintain Streets and Sidewalks
- Enhance The City's Drainage and Storm Sewer Capacity
- Assist in Promoting Economic Vitality
- Increase the Supply of Affordable Suitable Housing
- Create Additional Community Facilities and Public Services particularly transportation services

While all funding requests should address one of the above needs, approximately \$60,000 will be allocated to public service programs.

For more information regarding this process there will be a choice of two training meetings/public hearings, scheduled on **Thurs., Jan. 19 at 11 a.m.**, and **Tues., Jan. 24 at 4 p.m.** at the Conway City Hall Conference Room (1201 Oak St.) **Applications will only be accepted from any person or organization that attends a training meeting.** The meetings are open to both non-profit and for-profit organizations.
